

CIVILIAN-MILITARY PAY RAISES SINCE YEAR 2010

During the eight years since 2010, civilian pay rose a total of about 19 percent, as measured by the Employment Cost Index, compared to military pay raises that collectively boosted average basic pay by about 16 percent.
